

## **Penal Code**

### **Section 37.02 PERJURY:**

- (a) A person commits an offense, if with intent to deceive and with knowledge of the statement's meaning:
  - (1) he/she makes a false statement under oath or swears to the truth of a false statement previously made; and
  - (2) the statement is required or authorized by law to be made under oath.

- (b) An offense under this section is a Class A Misdemeanor.

### **Section 37.03 AGGRAVATED PERJURY:**

- (a) A person commits an offense if he/she commits perjury as defined in Section 37.02 of this code, and the false statement:
  - (1) is made during or in connection with an official proceeding; and
  - (2) is material

- (b) An offense under this section is a Felony of the Third Degree.
